






Please note that AT are being very communicative and putting plans in place to mitigate disruptions to our school, particularly at drop off and pick up times.

PMP helpers needed – Parents and grandparents we are starting our popular and highly valuable PMP programme on Thursday and Friday mornings in Terms 2 and 3. We need YOU! Waterskiing Nationals 2024 - Congratulations to Eddie Donald (Rm 8) who recently represented the Auckland region at the 2024 New Zealand Waterskiing National Championships held at Piarere, Waikato. Eddie, having just turned 8, was the youngest athlete to qualify for the event, with the oldest athlete being 93 years young & still going strong competing! The Donald
