Parish News - School/Church working-bee this Saturday: Following the immensely popular and successful School/Parish community working-bee the other week, back by popular demand, we will be having another working-bee this Saturday, 18 May, from 1pm, to instal the insulation in the Church for a few hours. Experts will be on-site to instruct and direct and all material/tools will be provided, including single-use protective gear. This will be one of the last chances to help out and be part of this incredible journey in renovating our beautiful Church. Church Services in the Parish/School Hall: A reminder that our Church is currently closed for renovations. Consequently, future Saturday night Vigil Masses at 5:30pm and Sunday Masses at 9am will be held in the Hall over the next few months. The Church renovation is progressing well with all 11 new arched windows installed last week thanks to Jeremy at Allpro Construction Limited and his band of merry men. We remain equally grateful to Julieta Gagna Mariadas of PDL who generously supplied a lot of electrical products for the Church reno. gratis.

Planting: Further to last week's School Newsletter, the Parish Finance Committee managed to convince Auckland Council to buy the plants that are required to be planted under the billboards on the School field, saving \$'000s. We will look at planting the 95 plants (being small grasses and flaxes) at the end of June and will be in touch nearer the time to organise a working-bee to effect this.

Children's Liturgies: (a break-out session for kids involving a wee bit of gospel and heaps of colouring in and fun discussion) during Sunday Masses is back on for the School Term 2 - so please come along and join our welcoming Parish community - it will be like a huge play date for the kids, plus we have a morning tea in the Hall after both Saturday and Sunday Masses.
