#### Information from Auckland Transport -

Thank you to all the parents who attended this afternoon's meeting and those who sent through questions and comments to pass on to AT. Topics of discussion included parking challenges on Montrose and the surrounding streets, illegal parking (e.g. in 5 minute zones, parking over yellow lines and driveways etc), how road works are impacting on drop off and pickup, abandoned cars on Montrose taking up valuable parking spots, parents receiving parking fines etc etc.

The big piece of news from AT is that the next stage of upgrades roadworks will include the closure of Pt Chev Rd from the Great North Rd intersection to Montrose Street (Montrose will stay open at all times to residence and school traffic). The dates of these closures have not yet been finalised but are expected in the coming weeks. When this happens AT will provide clear information about how to access Montrose Street (it won't be easy, but it will be possible!) and will be staffing a Walking School Bus each morning and afternoon (probably to and from the car park behind Daily Bread / KFC). While this closure will definitely impact of school traffic, AT are trying to be as helpful and proactive as possible.




As soon as we have more information we will send it out to our community. We will also be sending out, on behalf of AT, a survey / expression of interest regarding the Walking School Bus.

Church Renovation Update - We are hoping to have the gib installed by the end of this week and

remain on target to finish the reno. by the end of July/August - so not too long to go now. Jeremy Halpin from Allpro Construction Limited and his band of merry men have been doing a great job with the reno. We remain equally grateful to Julieta Gagna Mariadas of PDL who generously supplied a lot of electrical products for the Church reno. gratis. A summary of the Church renovation costs incurred to date versus budget is shown below (\$'000 excluding GST):

Church reno - in short, we are on our own in that we have to self-fund it, there is no contribution from the Auckland Diocese and Churches are unable to apply for grants for renovating it's Church. Hence, the call-out for the "Buy-the-brick" campaign - refer below.


