A message from Auckland Transport regarding the Walking School Bus starting next week due to the Pt Chev Road closure scheduled to start on Monday:

Thank you to the families that completed the recent Walking School Bus (WSB) trial survey. The response showed that over 90% preferred the Daily Bread/KFC car park as the start and end point for the route.



We are pleased to advise that the Walking School Bus trial will start from this location on Monday 17th June for a two-week period. During the trial the WSB will operate both morning and afternoon Monday to Friday and will be managed by the Auckland Transport Community Transport team, parents are welcome to walk with their children on the Walking School Bus if they wish to do so.

WSB will operate the following times -

Before school - 8.20am - Parents must be with their children in the carpark and must stay with them until the WSB leaves at 8.30am sharp - the drop location will be marked by AT flags.

After school - Children to assemble on the top court at 3.05pm, leaving school at 3.10pm sharp.

Parents to be in car park by 3.00pm - any child who is not collected by 3.25pm - the school will be notified and collect them from the car park and return them to school for parent pick up.

Following the two-week trial, we will hold a parent meeting to discuss the next steps.

Safety information:

- · Mrs Bateman and Miss Neary will accompany the Walking School on Monday morning and afternoon, and from then on it will be run independently by AT staff (employed and trained by AT).
- · Children signed up for the Walking School Bus will be checked off at the beginning of the Walking School Bus and at the end, to ensure the safety of all involved.
- · If there is an incident or an issue on the Walking School Bus parents will be informed immediately.
- · AT have conducted a 'Safety Audit' to ensure the safest route for the Walking School Bus.


