- Your child must be baptised Catholic, with a Baptism certificate
- Your child must have had their 9th birthday before the programme starts
- Your child must attend weekend Mass
- At least I parent must attend the adult sessions with Father John
- There will be no make-up classes so please ensure your child can make all the classes

Reconciliation (during Lent): Lesson 1 - 9 March, Lesson 2 - 16 March, Lesson 3 - 23 March, Service in the Church - 25 March @ 6.30pm

First Holy Communion: Lesson 1 - 1 June, Lesson 2 - 8 June, Lesson 3 - 15 June, Practice - 21 June in the Church @ 4.00pm, Mass - 22 June @ 9.00am

Confirmation: Lesson 1 - 2 November, Lesson 2 - 9 November, Lesson 3 - 16 November, Practice - 22 November in the Church @ 4.00pm, Mass with Bishop Steve - 23 November @ 9.00am A donation of \$50 per child is required to cover the cost of resources throughout the programme. 
