<u>A visit from Brother Phillip</u> - Last week we joined with our friends from Christ the King School to listen to Brother Phillip from the St Francis Retreat Center. Here is the reflection Room 4 wrote about the visit: Brother Phillip lives at the Franciscan Friary in Hillsborough. He was dressed in a brown robe and sandals just like St Francis did. He knew lots of stories about St Francis. Brother Phillip spoke to St Francis and Christ the King School about St Francis of Assisi. He told us why St Francis had holes in his hands and feet just like Jesus did when he died on the cross. St Francis loved creation. He talked to the animals and called the sun and moon, Brother Sun and Sister Moon.

School Canopy Update - A great wee impromptu working-bee last weekend removed the old pergola awning in front of Rooms 4 and 5 in preparation for the new canopy. We managed to raise \$1,500 from the sale of the old metal frame (which will be repurposed), with the funds going towards protection pads for the new canopy poles and the new canopy sound system. As noted last week, the fabrication process for the new canopy commences this month with final installation and Council sign-off planned before the end of April.



Next planned project: Decking and Seating next to the School upper court and Church – In conjunction with the Church, we are planning on decking the currently unused no-man's land between the School upper turfed court and the Church. The plan is to have built-in bench seating around the perimeter of the deck and around the existing Kauri tree. This will utilise this great space for the School Community parents and kids as well as the Church parishioners for socialising. Accordingly, we are seeking much needed donations to fund this



exciting new project, which again are tax deductible, and can take the form of a "Brick(s)" (refer above). The rudimentary picture above is a "non-artists" impression from Stuart.

<u>A message from the Junior teachers about Healthy Lunches</u> – St Francis Catholic School encourages healthy lunches with vegetable pieces, fruit, sandwiches or a bun, wrap, sushi, or dumplings to sustain them throughout the day. Including a small sweet treat is fine. Water bottles to be filled with water only, no other drinks needed. Water is best for teeth and hydration. As we know some of our children travel a distance to get to school and have early breakfasts, we have a brain break/snack at around 10am. Please make sure your child knows how to open any wrappers, packets and bottles. Cheese or yoghurt is great if the twist top has been loosened. We send home any peels, wrappers or packets to reduce rubbish around the school grounds.

We want our school and our community to be a safe place for all children. Our tamariki are growing up in rapidly changing times, and the risk, frequency, and severity of online harm are increasing. We need to tackle this as a community.

As such, we have organised Filmmaker, Author, and Speaker Rob Cope, Producer of the documentary "Our Kids Online" to come and give what promises to be a humorous and eye-opening evening talk to our parent community.

His talk will cover:

- Cyberbullying How bullies can reach our kids 24/7
- Social media How social media is affecting the mental health in 3 out of 5 children. FOMO, depression, anxiety
- Gaming and the developing brain An oversupply of dopamine leading to dopamine deficiency, synaptic pruning, and the underdevelopment of social skills and empathy
- Online predators The methods they use, how to spot them
