All Saints Day (Saturday November 1st) and All Souls Day (Sunday November 2nd), are a period for remembering and praying for the faithful departed and celebrating the saints in heaven.

- All Saints Day - A feast day honoring all the saints in heaven, known and unknown, who have achieved holiness. It's a day to celebrate heroes of the faith who lived lives of holiness and to pray for their intercession.
- All Souls Day - A day to remember and pray for the souls of all the faithful departed, including loved ones and those with no one to pray for them. This helps children to understand that death is not the end and reinforces the Catholic belief in God's love and mercy for those who have died.

All Saints Day will be celebrated at the Saturday and Sunday Masses this weekend, along with **a celebration of our new students at the 9.00am Mass on Sunday**. All Souls day will be celebrated on Monday the 3rd of November at 7.00pm in the Church.
